Students' Feedback Analysis Report : Consolidated

ACADEMIC YEAR : 2020-21

The 140 format for filling students' feedback in regards to Academic, Administrative, Sports, Cultural Extension Activities and Support Service were distributed to the (3rd Year) students of this college. The filled in formats are collected and analyzed. The findings of the students' feedback report.

A. Academic Aspect :

1. Usefulness of the syllabus:

From the analysis of the students' feedback forms, it was found that 955 of the students rated the usefulness of the present syllabus as "adequate", but with regard to meeting the need of life, 80% of the students rated the syllabus as "fair" while 20% of the student rated the syllabus as "adequately" sufficient to meeting the needs of life.

2. Internal Evaluation system :

In this regards, more than 90% of the students rated the system as excellent while 10% of the students rated it as "adequate". However, students opined that the internal evaluation system is helpful in self assessment.

3. Teaching Quality :

From the analysis of the students' feedback, it was observed that above 85% of the students' rated that they are satisfied with the quality of teaching that they receive in the college. However, that they receive in the college. However, mixed responses were received with regard to coverage of the syllabus. About 70-75% of the students opined that 50-70% of the courses is covered in a given semester.

B. Students' feedback on Teacher :

1. Student-Teacher Relationship:

In this regard 98% of the students reported that they share "Very Good" relationship with the teachers of their respective department.

2. Methodology of Teaching:

Mixed responses were received in this regard. 60-70% of the students opined that "Lecture" method is followed in the classroom while 30-40% of the students reported that "demonstration-cum-discussion" method is followed in the classroom.

3. Teachers, Feedback on internal assessment :

In this regards, 95% of the students reported that teacher provide "helpful comment" on their performance after the internal assessment.

4. Teachers Reference of E-content :

In this regard, only 40% of the students reported that teachers hardly refer to e-content. 55% of the students reported that teachers never refer to e-content in classroom. However, only 5% of the teachers regularly refer to e-contents the students reported.

5. Teachers' help in project work :

About teachers availability, guiding and timely feedback in project work, 955 of the students reported that teachers, offer full support and assistance to them.

6. Guiding extra-curricular activities :

In this regard 705 of the students reported that teacher "regularly" guide them for extra-curricular activity while 30% of the students reported that teacher "rarely" extend help in guiding extra-curricular activities.

7. Departmental Library :

In this regard 80% of the students reported that books are "rarely" available in the departmental library while 20% of the students opined that they "regularly" receive book from the departmental library.

C. Feedback on Support Service:

1. Library usefulness:

About 90% of the students reported that they are satisfied with the catalogue arrangement of books, availability of reading space, newspaper and e-content (N-List) of the library.

2. Network Resource Centre functioner :

In this regard 95% of the students expressed dissatisfaction. In matters relating to access of interest centre as and when required and co-operation of the staff, students reported dissatisfaction and stated that they do not get to access the services of network resource centre.

D. Administration Standards:

1. Progress report distribution :

85% of the students reported that they receive progress report in time

2. Working of sanitary system :

In this regard 90% of the students reported that toilets are not properly and regularly cleaned. Even they reported that the conditions of some classroom are deplorable owing to the lack of infrastructure development.

3. Service of Canteen:

98% of the students reported that the college canteen is not functional.

4. Students welfare scheme:

70% of the students reported that they receive help from the students welfare scheme while 305 students suggested that the students welfare scheme is not helpful at all.

5. Laboratory :

In this regard 855 of the students expressed satisfaction. However, 15% of the students reported that there is considerable lack of instruments in the laboratories.

6. Working of NSS & YRC:

Both NSS & YRC services are functional and majority of students reported that they are engaged in social service through NSS & YRC.

7. Scholarship Facilities:

About Scholarship facilities, 90% of the students reported that they scholarship facilities Such as State Scholarship, National Scholarship, UG Merit Scholarship and Students Freeship scholarship are available in the college.

Teachers' Feedback consolidated Report

Academic Year: 2020-2021

As per your Order No. 245/20 Dt: 10.10.2020 the feedback forms numbering 25 were distributed to the teacher 20 samples were collected and analyzed. The finding of teacher's opinion is hereunder for your kind perusal.

1. Opinion about the students :

The teachers reported that the learning capacity of the students is good but they lack in communication skill. They also reported that at students face socio-economic challenger in their respective families it sometime s becomes difficult for them to attend classes as a regular

2. Classroom difficulties :

90% of the teachers reported that lack of technical equipments / instruments and internet facility is one of the major challenges they face while delivering lecture. Teachers also reported that due to inadequate infrastructure, the classrooms are smaller in size and not properly developed.

3. Method of content delivery :

From the analysis of the teachers' feedback forms it was observed the 95% of the teachers follow the lecturer method in the delivery of content in the classroom. However, some teachers reported that they use ICT tools and e-content in the classroom. It was also found that some teachers use both ICT tools and demonstration-cum-teaching method in the delivery of content.

4. Assisting students in providing advice for academic, employment and career counseling.

Most teachers reported that they provide and coursed their students. 50% of the teachers reported that they communicate employment related never to their students, and students are also informed about the recent developments in their respective field of study. It was also found that some teachers assist their students by being available beyond the boundary of the classroom campus.

5. Five weakness of the college

From the analysis of the teachers' feedback reports the following weakness of the college were found :

1. Lack of teaching and non-teaching staff
2. Lack of Classroom
3. Lack of adequate infrastructure
4. Lack of internet/wi-fi facility
5. Lack of books and journals in the library.
6. Lack of instruments in the laboratories.
7. Lack of honours departments.

6. Five strengths of the College :

The teachers reported the following strengths :

1. Large campus area
2. Good result
3. Good examination system
4. Full strength admission
5. Staff are very co-operative
6. Beautiful garden and clean campus
7. Good library.

7.. Contribution to research and innovation :

In this regard the teachers reported that they organize seminar and workshops. The incubation centre is a great asset to research and innovation. Some teacher also reported that they write books and articles in journals.

8. Seminar, workshops, symposium and Training programme organized:

In this regard the teachers reported that all the departments of the college organize seminar, workshops in every academic session. Apart from that the college also offers various certificate courses such as the teaching of Geeta and communicative English for the holistic growth of the students.

9. Steps to be taken for improvement of Academic, setup, Quality Improvement, Innovation, Research, Activities and Support Services of the college.

In this regards, the teachers suggested the following.

1. Subscription to journals to be initiated.
2. Adequate faculties are to be recruited to cover the courses.
3. More non-teaching staff are required for the Administrative and Accounts Section.
4. Men's hostel is required.
5. Infrastructure to be developed.

Consolidated Report on Feedback of Parents

Academics Session: 2020-21

The feedback formats filled in all respects are collected from parents in regards to the prospect of their wards pursuing studies in this institution. The data in the feedback are consolidated and analyzed to report the findings hereunder for further course of action at the end of the college authorities.

1. Regarding the prospect of students

In this regard the parents gave positive feedback by rating the educational prospect of their wards as "excellent". In their rating, they remarked that their wards receive quality teaching in the college.

2. Usefulness of syllabus and teaching standard :

In this regard the parents reported that the CBSC syllabus taught in the college is designed keeping in mind the practical needs of students, lives. Parents also remarked that quality teaching is provided to their wards. However, they expressed dissatisfaction regarding the lack of undergraduate courses in many streams.

3. Future plan of the ongoing students:

Regarding the future plan of the students, parents reported that they would allow their wards to consult the career counseling and employment cell to opt for their future career. However, parents reported that the college should take initiation to introduce classes for various competitive examinations.

4. Suggestions of Parents for improvement of Academic, Administrative and other practices:

In this regard the parents gave the following feedback suggestions:

1. More teaching staff to be recruited.
2. Adequate infrastructure to be developed
3. ICT tools enabled / smart classrooms to be set-up.
4. Internal facilities to be made available in the campus.
5. More books to be stored in the Library.
