All the eligible ST/SC/OBC/SEBC/EBC (Economically Backward Class) students studying at Post Matriculation courses are hereby informed that the online submission of duly filled-in Fresh / Renewal applications in PRERANA Portal for the year 2019-20 for Post-Matric Scholarship and Financial Assistance to ST Students studying in National Level Institutes scheduled to be held as per the date line indicated below.

#### (i) Eligibility Criteria for Post Matric Scholarship Schemes:-

- (1) Student shall belong to ST/SC/OBC/SEBC/EBC community and should be a permanent resident of Odisha.
- (2) The students should continue their Post Matriculation Studies in any general/technical or professional courses in any Govt. or Govt. recognized Private Institutes.
- (3) The annual family income of the parent/guardians from all sources in case of ST/SC students should not exceed Rs.2,50,000/- per annum.
- (4) The annual family income of the parent/guardians from all sources in case of OBC/SEBC students should not exceed Rs.1,50,000/- per annum and they have to secure atleast 50% marks in previous examination.
- (5) The annual family income of the parent/guardians from all sources in case of EBC students (GENERAL Category Other than SC/ST/OBC/SEBC) should not exceed Rs.1,00,000/- per annum. In case of EBC students, he/she should be pursuing his/her higher study in Government institute ONLY.



## Guidelines for selection of students for award of different scholarship under "Medhabruti" Scheme for the year 2019-20.

### OBJECTIVE

The Government of Odisha in Higher Education Department have been awarding scholarship each year under the Scheme 'e-medhabruti' out of State budget to provide financial assistance to the meritorious students of Odisha from families whose parental income does not exceed 6.00 lakhs to meet a part of their educational expenses while pursuing their higher studies.

### SCOPE:

The scholarships are awarded for pursuing general courses i.e.+3(Sr.), P.G, Technical & Professional courses in Colleges and Universities inside and outside Odisha.

### Type , Number & Duration of Scholarships:

It is envisaged to provide the following types of scholarships as below:

The Government of Odisha in Higher Education Department have been awarding scholarship each year for encouragement to the meritorious students for prosecuting their higher studies in the field of general (+2 (Jr.), +3 (Sr.) & P.G.) Courses as well as Technical/Professional education. This has necessitated for issue of guidelines pertaining to the selection procedure of eligible students for award of such scholarship.

ORDER

ST&SC students having parental annual income upto Rs.2.5 lakhs. OBC students having parental annual income upto Rs.1.5 lakhs and EBC students having parental annual income of Rs.1.0 lakhs are eligible to get scholarship under PRERANA scheme of ST & SC Development and M & BC Welfare Department. These students are also eligible to get scholarship under e-medhabruti scholarship scheme of Higher Education Department. Therefore, in order to avoid duplicacy, it has been decided to exclude the above mentioned categories of students from the ambit of e-medhabruti scholarship scheme of Higher Education Department; by amending the eligibility condition of e-medhabruti scholarship scheme guideline as given below.

"v. The annual income of the parents from all sources should be between Rs. 2.5 lakhs to Rs. 6.00 lakhs in case of the ST/SC category students, between Rs. 1.5 lakhs to 6.00 lakhs in case of OBC category students and between 1.0 lakhs to Rs. 6.00 lakhs in case of EBC category students."

All other terms and conditions of e-medhabruti schemes guideline remain intact.

The above-mentioned ST, SC, OBC and EBC category students are advised to apply for PRERANA scholarship scheme of ST & SC Development and M & BC Welfare Department. They shall not be considered for e-medhabruti scholarship of Higher Education Department from 2019-20 Academic Year.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

Various scholarships are being awarded by State Government and Government of India to meritorious/meritorious and poor students of Orissa for pursuing higher studies including studies in Technical and Professional education. From the financial year 2010-11 the State Government have revised the rate and number of scholarships awarded by the State Government. Government have also relaxed the income ceiling of parents, wherever applicable, so as to enable more meritorious and meritorious-cum-poor students to avail the opportunity. The application procedure has also been simplified and now students can submit their applications for any of these scholarships awarded by both Government of India and State Government as per their eligibility by using a Common Application Form for award of scholarship.

### Scholarships awarded by Government of Orissa

The detail guidelines and the common application format are available in the Department website: [www.dheorissa.in](http://www.dheorissa.in). Candidates are required to submit the application for the scholarship awarded by State Government **ONLINE** and obtain the print out, put their signature and submit the same in the office of the Principal of the concerned college on or before **31.10.2010** along with necessary documents, where required. While submitting the application the applicant should indicate his/her bank account number, branch and name of the bank so that the scholarship amount can be directly transferred to his/her account **online** through the bank. The Principals are required to countersign the applications and submit the same to the Under Secretary, Scholarship, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Orissa, Bhubaneswar so as to reach on or before **15.11.2010**.

## **Amount & Period of Scholarship:**

This scholarship is awarded at the rate of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only per month (for ten month in an academic year) for the entire duration of the course subject to fulfillment of terms and conditions laid down in Government Resolution No.65763 dt. 28.11.2000 and as amended by resolution No.68750 dt. 27.12.03 of the Department of Higher Education, Government of Orissa.

## **Scholarship awarded by Government of India**

### **1. National Merit Scholarship:**

#### ● **Objective:**

To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from low income families to meet part of their day to day expenses while pursuing higher studies. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the result of higher secondary examination 2010 conducted by CHSE, Orissa.

#### ● **Eligibility:**

Students who secured marks above the 80<sup>th</sup> percentile mark in +2 examination conducted by CHSE shall be eligible to get this scholarship. Students securing more than 405 marks in Arts, 439 in Commerce and 446 in Science can apply for this scholarship.

#### ● **Rate of Scholarship:**

The rate of scholarship would be Rs.1,000/- p.m. at Graduation level for first three years of college and University courses and Rs.2,000/- per month at Post-Graduation level. Students pursuing professional courses would get Rs.2,000/- per month in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year. The scholarship would be paid for 10 months in an academic year.

Children of parents having an annual income from all sources up to 4.5 lakhs will be eligible to apply for this scholarship.

- **Limitations:**

# Scholarship

- **Limitations:**

The state quota for this scholarship is around 2,700 numbers to be distributed among eligible passouts of the Science, Commerce and Humanities of the CHSE. The ratio is 3:2:1.

- **Reservation:**

At present, reservations for the various categories are : SC-15%, ST-7½%, OBC 27% and horizontally 3% for Physically Handicapped in all the categories.

- **How to apply:**

Student to submit his/her application in the Common Application Form for Award of Scholarship (CAFAS) ONLINE and should get the print out and submit the same to the Principal of the concerned college along with Income Certificate of parents and certificate in support of Reservation claim, if any, from appropriate authority by **31.10.2010**. The Principal should countersign the applications and submit it to the Secretary, Council of Higher Secondary Education, Bhubaneswar on or before **15.11.2010**.

## MODE OF PAYMENT

On submitting the application the applicant should indicate his/her bank account number, branch and name of the bank so that the scholarship amount can be directly transferred to his/her account online through the bank.

There is no second or Supplementary Examination for +3 students. They can clear their back papers if any, paying prescribed fees in time without further attendance.

However instant Examination is there for +2 students. Students getting plucked in one subject only appear such Examination.

### Scholarships and Stipends

Students can avail themselves of the benefits of getting scholarships if they are selected and considered fit. Junior Merit Scholarship is awarded to +2 students on the results of Annual H.S.C. Examination based on merit basis alone.

Teacher's son scholarship is given to those who have secured atleast 60% marks in their H.S.C. Examination.

The Government of India awards scholarship to blind deaf and orthopaedically handicapped students who have secured atleast 40% of marks at the previous Examination.

Rashtriya Sanskrit Samsthan, New Delhi awards Sanskrit Scholarship to the bonafide scholars of Sanskrit for scoring maximum marks at H.S.C. and C.H.S. Examinations.

Govt. of India Hindi Scholarship is given to deserving students in order to encourage the study of Hindi.

Post - Matric scholarship is given to S.C. and S.T. students by the welfare Department of the Government of India.

Two other forms of scholarship are National Scholarship and National Loan Scholarship. One may get detail information from the scholarship section.

Besides, scholarships and stipends are given to those students scholarships, stipends are given to those students who are the sons and daughters of freedom figures. Free studentship is also given to the poor, needy and meritorious students if they apply with necessary documents in time.

Senior merit scholarship is given to the +3 or Degree students on the merit of their C.H.S. Examination. Students securing First Division may apply for such scholarship.

Book grant facility is also available which is given to the children of ex-service personnel and dependents.
