Report on Students Feedback 2021-22

The feedback forms were distributed to the students pursuing three years Undergraduate courses in the college. The feedback received from the students touch upon different aspects of the institution which are discussed as under the following themes.

a) Academic and curricular activities

Around Ninety-three percent students in this regard viewed that the curriculum is well designed. According to them, the CBCS syllabus poise to caters to the practical needs of their life. However it has also been observed that the CBCS syllabus helps them in research and innovative works and make help in their future life.

b) Faculty:

About the 85% of students reported that the faculties of this college are knowledgeable and helpful. Specifically the students also reported that teachers, content delivery is praiseworthy. About 10% of the students reported that it will be better if there will be more doubt clearing classes.

c) Academic Status and infrastructure:

About 60% of the students reported that the college does not have adequate smart class room lack of computers and Xerox facilities is an aspect of the academic value which the students have highlighted. The reported that the college does not have sufficient infrastructure.

d) Support Services and Extracurricular activities:

About 95% of the students gave negative feedback. They have identified the following area of improvement.

- The college administration communicate them information well in advance.
- ii. The carrier counseling cell of the college is not functioning well.
- iii. Students also reported that the grievance redressal cell has to start working because dysfunctional.
- iv. Women and sexual harassment cell needs to sensitise the students by organizing seminars and workshops.
- The students also reported that the NSS and YRC units of the college runs well.

e) Internships and Placement:

About 80% students reported that the college does not provide any internship facilities along with placement.

Report on Feedback of Employers-2021-22

Based on the feedback of the employers of the college the following report is prepared.

1. About the staff (both teaching and non-teaching)

On analyzing employers feedback the report regarding the staffs of the college the following points become evident.

- 80% of the employers reported that both teaching and nonteaching staff of the college are well mannered.
- ii) Employers pointed out that there is considerable shortage of both teaching and non-teaching staff. They raised concern the creation of more direct payment posts.
- iii) Employers reported that the teachers are burdened with administrative works.

2. About Campus Environment

90% of the employers reported that the college campus is properly organized. They highlight the following points

- i) There is lack of smart class room
- ii) Wi-fi facilities is to be provide for all students.
- iii) They specifically raised concern about the boys hostel.

3. Support Services:

90% of the employers provided positive feedback to the support services.

4. Students Performance:

Regarding the students performance 80% of the employers reported that the college evaluates students performance on a regular basis. However they mentioned when it comes to communication in English fails to show remarkable skill.

5. Extracurricular activities:

In this regards, 98% of the students reported that the colleges YRC and NSS wings performance are praiseworthy. However, 2% of the employers reported that the college does not have NCC.

The alumni feedback forms were distributed to the alumni of the college and this report is prepared based on their response. The alumni feedback responses can be discussed under the following headings.

College Infrastructure and Environment

The alumni expressed their satisfaction over the infrastructural development of the college that has occurred over the years. Around Eighty Three percent of the alumni opined that the college infrastructure is relatively developed. Consequently, the teaching-learning atmosphere has now become comfortable and conducive. However, all of them were of the view that there is still greater need of further infrastructure development in order to meet the requirement of all the stakeholders of the institution. According to them,

- i. Adequate classrooms need to be set up.
- ii. Provision of well-functioning internet (Wi-Fi) facility to facilitate academic and administrative activities.
- iii. Space enlargement or expansion of the reading room with a view to accommodate sufficient number of students.
- iv. Text book and reference book stock in the library should be increased so as to meet the demands of the students and faculties.

Role of the teacher in Imparting Education

In this regard, eighty to eighty-five percent of the alumni members reported that the teachers of the college are committed and highly skilled. They emphasizes the following points—

- Adequate number of teachers should be appointed.
- b. The teacher with doctorate degree should be more in number.
- c. The teacher should use smart classes

Support Services

The alumni of the opinion that now a days the students face various issues for which they need proper and timely counseling. Around, Seventy-five percent of the alumni members suggested that the support services for the students needs to be improved.

Extra-Curricular Activities

Ninety percent of the alumni viewed that the NSS and YRC units of the college have done commendable work by organizing blood donation camps, plantation drive, sanitation campaign and different kinds of awareness campaigns both within and outside the college campus.
