



GOPALPUR COLLEGE, GOPALPUR, BALASORE
STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY REPORT, 2018 – 19

It is to report that 250 numbers of feedback of students in respect to their satisfaction was collected in the month of January, 2019. The findings of the survey is given below taking the majority opinion into account.

1. About coverage of syllabus (Department-wise)

2. Teachers' preparation for lesson work:

80% of the students expressed satisfaction about the teachers lesson planning. But 20% of the students feel that the teachers lesson plan do not lead them to effective learning.

3. Teachers communication and approaching skill:

Students have positive feedback on the teachers' communication and appropriateness skill. The analysis of the report shows that 85% of the students are happy with the teachers' communication and presentation skills. But only 15% of the students have been dissatisfied with such skill of the teachers.

4. Internal evaluation of student's progression:

Nearly 100% of the students have expressed their satisfaction with the Internal Examination evaluation system. They have appreciated the teachers' support in analyzing their drawback in answer scripts.

5. Teachers relationship with the students as mentor:

The student's Satisfaction Survey Report that 98% of them are satisfied with the teacher student relationship. They rated their teacher's relation with the students to be "very good". But only 20% of the students have reported that the teachers have "good" bond with them.

6. Teachers interest in internship/visits/students exchange:

About 85% of the students reported that the teachers actively worked to sponsor them for study tour internship/visit/students exchange. But 15% of the students reported that the teachers promotion for the above purpose is not satisfactory.

7. Multiple approach to learning variables:

The students have reported the teacher using the various learning producers but they expressed their dissatisfaction with using ICT in the class room.

8. Information on course outcome and programme outcome

About 80% of the students reported that the teachers inform meet the standard in conformity with course and programme outcome 'every time' but 20% of them maintained that the teacher "usually" guide as mentor to fulfill their course aspiration.

9. Follows up action towards interested task:

71% of the students said that the teachers are ready to following up the students in assigned task. But 29% of the students feel unhappy.

10. Identifying weakness of students and guide for improvement:

About 90% of the students report that the teacher always help then to identify their weakness and advise to rectify the problems. But 10% of the students have dissatisfaction on the role of teacher.

11. Using students centric participatory learning system:

About 69% of the students report that the teachers are students centric and use participatory method to a great extent. While 31% of the students opined that the teachers use difficult method that they do not understand.

12. Encouraging participating in extra-curricular activities:

About 95% of the students "strongly agree" that the teachers encourage them to take part in extracurricular activities. But 5% disagree on the matter.

13. Use of soft skill, life skill, employability skill

About 70% of the students reported that the teachers make efforts to include soft skill and employability skills while 30% decline the question.

14. Percentage of using ICT tools, LCD projector, Multimedia

As per the students satisfaction survey report, 50% of the students say average teachers use ICT tools, LCD projectors and multimedia. While another 50% suggest that teacher do not use such tools properly.

15. Students suggestion for improvement of teachers learning and evaluation system

The students suggested such improvement in future.

- i. Need for digital classroom.
- ii. Need for free Wi-Fi.
- iii. Need for more teaching staffs.
- iv. Need for digital library .
- v. Need for college bus.
- vi. Need for strong departmental libraries.
- vii. Need for departmental smart classrooms.
- viii. Need for proper sanitary system.
