9. The Principal or the Principal-in-Charge may intimate the donor , at least before two weeks , to attend the award giving ceremony .





Objectives:

1. The Equal Opportunity Cell is a welfare agency founded under Promotion of Equity in Higher Education Institution Regulation Act. 2012 of the Government of India.
2. The same is constituted with a view to aid and advise the disadvantaged and marginalized section of students including Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Community, Minority, Physically challenged like – blind, deaf, lame, dumb, mentally retard, trans-gender, ambulated, deformed or mutilated person, alcoholic and BPL class students pursuing studies in this institution.
3. India as a country of diversity with different castes, creed, culture and religion is characterized by highly entrenched system of social stratifications that needs to support its weaker section to avail equal opportunity in the place of education.
4. Though women constitute about half of the population of the country the traditional outlook cause social inequality and gender disparity depriving dignity, identity and right to them.
5. Though the minorities constitute about 22% of population of the country their interest to have equal right and opportunity is neglected.

6. The physically challenged and deformity are treated as a negative curse by the healthy section. So, this weaker section is to be assisted financially, mentally, socially and academically. Hence, sensitization and empowerment of marginalized and weaker groups is utmost necessity.
7. It is urgent to ensure equity and equal opportunity as well as barrier free campus and fair chances for all (both students & staff) of the college.
8. The Equal Opportunity Cell is an inclusive educational system aiming at social security and empowerment of weaker section with disability to offer a friendly environment and effective assistance.
9. Hence, the Equal Opportunity Cell is formed in this institution to assist the weaker section students for successful completion of programme of studies in the campus without discrimination.

Function of Equal Opportunity Cell:

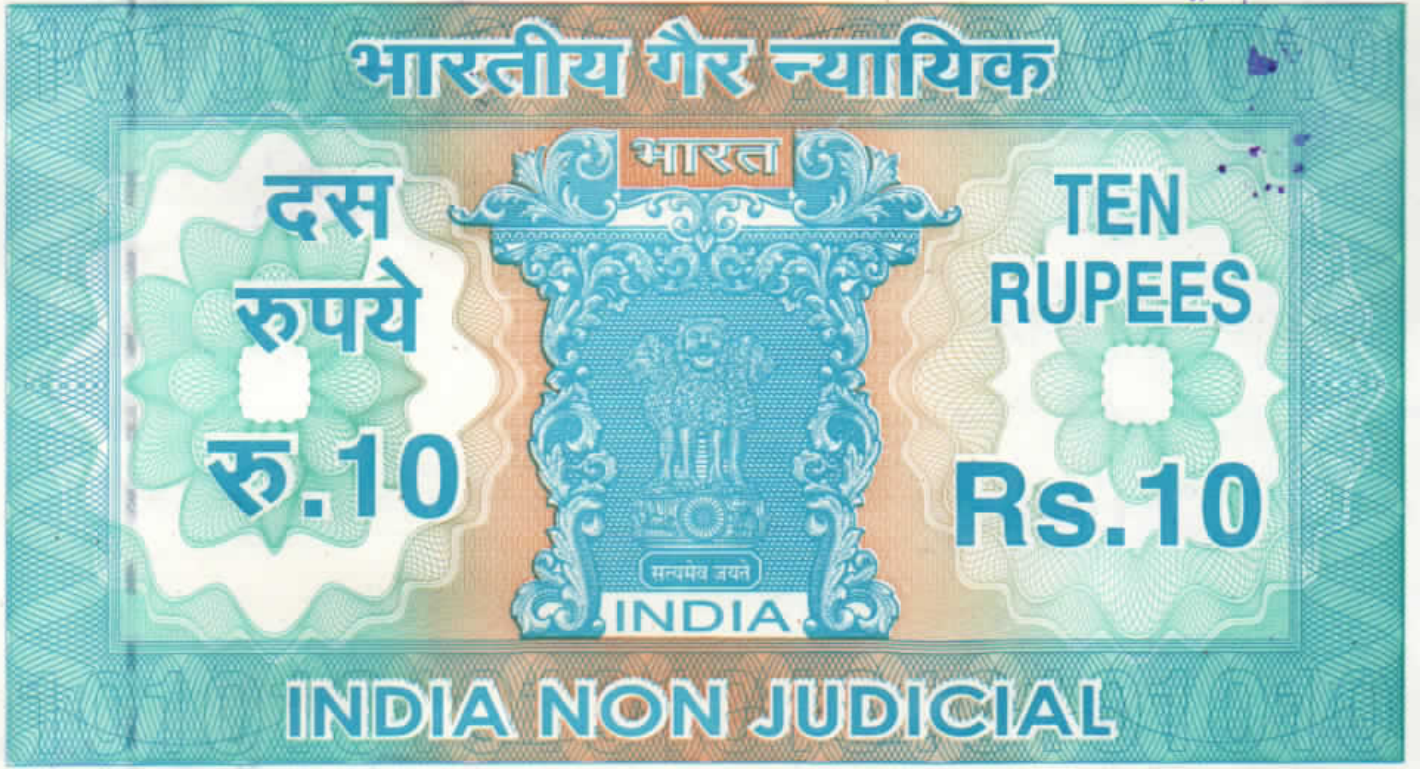
- i. To conduct access audit by certified agencies for a barrier free entrance to Parking-shed, Classrooms, Students' Common-room, Auditorium, Canteen, Laboratories, Library, Hostel, Administrative Office, Playfield and other support services.
- ii. Identifying and mapping individual needs of the students with disabilities, right from their application process, and course work till their placement. This includes accessibility to admission process, entrance examination, orientation, accommodation, fieldwork, research, reading room and examination Hall.
- iii. To arrange awareness and sensitization programme to promote consciousness to remove discrimination of weaker section.
- iv. To introduce short term career guidance, counseling vocational training course and skill promoting employability of the disabled.
- v. To facilitate in converting reading material into e-text, notes and Braille.
- vi. To facilitate accessible transport services for weaker section.
- vii. Setting up training and resource centre to feed educational needs of the students with disabilities in visual, hearing, orthopedic and neurological problems.
- viii. To conduct seminar / workshop for raising awareness about disabilities elderly abuse, promoting respect for senior citizens and making aware of Government's welfare programme for them.

- ix. To facilitate statutory requirement of the person with disability in the teaching, Learning and employment process.
- x. To hear grievance if any discrimination of such disabled enrolled.
- xi. The Advisor of the Equal Opportunity Cell shall work as the Co-ordinator of the programmes with a monthly honorarium of Rs. 1000/- from UGC to monitor / organize the programmes as resolved in the cell. He shall be responsible for effective functioning of the cell including gender sensitization and sexual harassment.
- xii. The committee should meet at least once in every four months and action taken decisions are to be reviewed in subsequent meeting.

- Terms of the Award:** 2. The Award will be given Annual to the College Topper in Annual H.S. Examination. This will continue unbreakably until the fund exists.
- Place of the Award:** 3. The place of Award will be only Gopalpur College, Gopalpur, Dist: Balasore and the Principal of the College by designation shall be the authorized person to manage the account. In no case shall the account and its offices be shifted to some other place until the donors consent to it in writing.
- Purpose of the Award:** 4. The award is hereby constituted to recognize the best student of Higher Secondary MIL (Sans.)/Elective in Arts/Science/Commerce class who excelled in studies in Sanskrit language & literature that the award is conferred in honor of this college founding member Late Maheswar Mishra and Solochana Devi who were resident of village Odasal, Dist: Balasore. In other way such awards will foster competition and encouragement among the students in pursuit of Sanskrit Studies.
- Beneficiaries and**
- Recipients of the Award:** 5. The students of Higher Secondary classes of Arts/Science/Commerce streams of Gopalpur College, Gopalpur, Dist: Balasore who stood first in Annual H.S. Examination of concern Council shall be the only beneficiary and recipient of the award.

**Fund of the Award:**

6. The capital amount Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) for MIL (Sans.)/Elective in Arts/Science/Commerce pledged and fixed in the name of the Principal by designation shall be the funding source of the award and in no case the same shall be withdrawn for its purpose or some other purpose. Only the interest accrued in the account shall be withdrawn for the purpose of award of Annual H.S. Examination.

Mode of Selection:

7. The Principal with a screening committee with senior most members shall decide the name of the student every year who shall be the beneficiary and awardee for the academic year. The students who have secured highest mark in Annual H.S. Exam in MIL (Sans.) /Elective in Arts/Science/Commerce shall be awarded such honor. To finalize the score of marks and deciding the merit, only the MIL (Sans.)/Elective subjects by the Council shall be taken into consideration. The score, grade and mark secured by the students in foundation and basic courses or any other subjects at the college shall not be taken consideration for selection of the awardee.

The Award and Prize:

8. The sum of cash prize and Testimonial shall be awarded to the beneficiary by person or to his/her representative at Foundation Day Celebration of the College. The awardees are to be intimated positively to receive such award. If there arises more than one candidate for one award, the cash prize will be equally distributed among the candidates.



- The expenditure and:** 9. The cost of communication.
- Cost of Award** Cash prize or any other expenditure in this regard shall be all borne/managed from this fund i.e. interest amount accrued annually from the pledging amount. The donors shall contribute separately a sum equal to the interest amount in cash to initiate such award in the Foundation year of the award – 2018.
- Intimation to Donor:** 10. The Principal or the Principal-in-Charge will intimate the donor, at least before two weeks, to attend the award giving ceremony.
- Management of Account:** 11. The Principal or Principal-in-charge of the college in writing with his/her seal and signature can withdraw the interest amount only ones just after its annual maturity for the purpose mentioned above. It is strictly prohibited to utilize the interest or its capital amount in any purposes other than it is meant for.
- Legality of the document:** 12. The above Rules and Provisions in form of statute shall guide all the purpose of such award and shall be taken as a legal document in future to decide any dispute, doubt and complicacies arising out of management, decision and continuation of such award
